ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES

1. All requests from charitable organizations, except those of a controversial nature will be considered for approval by the Superintendent.
2. The Superintendent will submit requests of a controversial nature to the Board for its approval.
3. Individual requests from organizations which have been approved by the Superintendent or Board will be referred to principals and student councils for their consideration.
4. Participation in fundraising endeavours by school classes or groups of students is to be voluntary and various forms of pressure are to be avoided.
