PREAMBLE

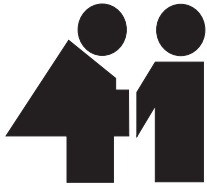
The Board allocates limited resources to support curricular, cocurricular, and extracurricular programs for the educational benefit of students. It recognizes that, in consultation with parents and students, teachers may plan some activities which exceed the allocation.

POLICY

THE BOARD INSTRUCTS THAT ANY ACTIVITY, EVENT, OR EXPERIENCE INCURRING A DIRECT COST TO STUDENTS, EVEN IF VOLUNTARY, CAN EXCEED THE SUM OF \$50.00 ONLY IF THE PRINCIPAL'S AND THE BOARD'S PERMISSION IS SECURED AND IF PARENTS ARE INFORMED OF THE ACTIVITY AND ATTENDANT COSTS IN THE EARLY STAGES OF PLANNING.

To minimize costs to students for curricular, cocurricular, and extracurricular programs.
