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POLICY

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES

1. A teacher-librarian trained in both librarianship and education will be provided for each school.
2. Whenever possible, trained clerical and technical staff shall be provided for each school.
3. Principals shall encourage in their schools the development of a rationale for the integration of library services and the instructional program. The rationale must be compatible with the school's philosophy.
4. The library in each school shall take on the character of a multimedia resource centre with relevant, current materials and equipment.
5. District staff shall ensure appropriate uniformity of practices and procedures among school libraries in the District.
6. Conditions permitting, principals shall provide student access to the library each day school is in session, providing services during the lunch period and at least one-half hour before classes begin in the morning and after they end in the afternoon.
