Superintendent's Report

Transitioning to School – Brandon's Story

University Highlands Elementary School principal Lori Driussi highlighted the work of the Learning Support Services team to create supportive, inclusive, caring communities where all children, specifically those with exceptional learning needs, can reach their full potential. Ms Driussi introduced Karen McKitrick-Twaites and her son, Brandon Twaites, a Kindergarten student at University Highlands. Ms McKitrick-Twaites outlined the challenges faced by Brandon, his transition to school and his experiences of integration and inclusivity. Ms McKitrick-Twaites described the Burnaby School District as an "incubator for innovation and inclusion.

Customized Employment Project

The district, in partnership with CBI (Communication, Behaviour and Instruction) Consultants and the Burnaby Association for Community Inclusion, has developed a Customized Employment program to support students with special needs in their transition from school to a work environment.

District Principal Deborah Simak and Dr. Paul Malette of CBI Consultants presented the project and shared "Eric's Story" – the story of a Burnaby high school student and his plans and goals for his transition from school to work.

Superintendent's Report on Student Achievement 2011-2012

In accordance with the requirements of the School Act, Superintendent of Schools Claudio Morelli presented his annual report on student achievement providing evidence and measures of student achievement in the areas of literacy, school completion, early learning and aboriginal education, as well as a progress report on children in care.
