Superintendent's Report

Esso Cup Student Progam

Armstrong Elementary Principal Ernie Kashima presented an overview of the Esso Cup National Female Midget Hockey Championship. The event, which is for girls aged 16-18, began in 2010. This year the Burnaby Minor Hockey Association hosted the event from April 21-27, with six teams participating from the West, Pacific, Ontario, Atlantic, Quebec and Prairie regions. In total, 5,712 students from Burnaby schools attended the games and supported the teams. Students Seina Kashima and Selena Doyle (Burnaby South) who acted as coordinators of the secondary school volunteers, shared with Trustees their experiences. Nelson Elementary Principal Dino Klarich introduced students Tanner Schuck and Monica Badial who described the visit by the Edmonton Thunder team to Nelson Elementary.

BYSN Do it Green Conference 2013

The Burnaby Youth Sustainability Network (BYSN) is a group of approximately 40 students who represent the sustainability and environmental clubs from the district's eight secondary schools. Assistant Superintendent Roberto Bombelli introduced BYSN Chair Jacqueline Shen (Burnaby South) and Vice-Chair An-Te Chu (Moscrop) who shared some of the highlights of the fourth annual BYSN Do it Green Conference. Over 250 students had registered for the conference, some

from other districts who have started or plan to start their own youth sustainability networks. Ms Shen and Mr. Chu also outlined BYSN's future plans, including participating in the new district Food Scrap Recycling Committee.

The BYSN is the recipient of the City of Burnaby's 2013 Environment Award for Youth.
