# **Superintendent's Report**

# Partners in Education Plus Pilot Program

Director of Instruction, Peter Dubinsky provided an overview of the *Partners in Education Plus* program, which provides onsite early learning programming for adult students with pre-school age children.

Executive Director, Jean Rasmussen from The Canucks Family Education Centre (CFEC) highlighted the successes of the program, which has provided school and family services for 10 years. CFEC acts as a conduit to support adult learners gain stronger English skills to improve employment opportunities. Program Manager for CFEC, Lina Arias shared the successes to date, for the 281 participants, including school age children. Adult student Cathy Ismail shared her experience of coming to Canada – a dream come true for her, to have the freedom to create the opportunity of a full life for herself and her family.

## <u>Inquiry</u> and <u>Innovation</u> in <u>Teaching</u> and <u>Learning</u> in the Early Years

Director of Instruction Wanda Mitchell provided an overview of the *Reggio Emilia* approach. Early Learning Helping Teacher, Angela Meredith explained how the program helps teachers provide learning experiences for students. Driven by curiosity and an interest in learning, each child has unlimited potential. This

learning experience explores the natural world around them, and the environment becomes the "third teacher".

Teachers Caroline Thomas, Kristen Brolin, Giovana Thiessen and Priscilla Yap provided examples of how this learning approach impacts students and families.
