

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT
Reporting to Public Session Tuesday, June 11, 2013

1. Partners in Education Plus Pilot Program

Partners in Education Plus is a program currently being piloted at Edmonds Community School. This unique learning opportunity highlights the strong partnership between district community schools and community organizations. The program is offered free of charge and provides onsite early learning programming for those adult students with pre-school age children. The intent is to provide courses that support adult fluency in English conversation, reading and writing. The program began in January 2013 and provides two courses in English Foundations through Burnaby Community and Continuing Education. The Canucks Family Education Centre (CFEC) provides early learning programming, lunch and snacks.

This evening, Director of Instruction, Peter Dubinsky, will introduce founder and Executive Director, Jean Rasmussen, and Program Manager for CFEC, Lina Arias, who will provide an overview of the program and highlight successes to date. Cathy Ismail, a student in the program, will also share her experiences.

Recommendation: THAT the Board receive this information.

2. Inquiry and Innovation in Teaching and Learning in the Early Years

Early primary children enter school with a natural curiosity for learning. This curiosity develops as they explore their directions in learning. The *Reggio Emilia* approach to learning, first introduced in Italy, helps teachers to provide learning experiences for students that include exploring the natural world around them in which the environment becomes the "third teacher".

This evening, Director of Instruction, Wanda Mitchell, will introduce Early Learning Helping Teacher, Angela Meredith. Accompanying Ms. Meredith are teachers Kristen Brodin and Caroline Thomas from Stride Community School, Giovana Thiessen from Windsor Elementary and Priscilla Yap from Brentwood Elementary who will share how this approach has impacted students and families.

Recommendation: THAT the Board receive this information.

3. 2013 - 2014 Student Fees (attachment)

In accordance with the School Act, the Board of Education is required to approve a schedule of student fees for the 2013-2014 school year. Current legislation requires that any material that is essential to the delivery of any school course that leads to graduation or school leaving must be offered free of charge with the following exceptions:

- Purchase of paper, writing tools, calculators (excluding graphing calculators) and other school supplies and equipment for a student's personal use

- School activity fees: agenda books, student activity dues, special events and graduation activities
- Purchase or rental of musical instruments for a student's personal use
- Purchase or rental of tools, materials or equipment for a student's personal use in trades training or apprenticeship programs
- Schools may also charge fees for extra-curricular or enrichment activities on a cost recovery basis. This includes, but is not limited to, enrichment field trips where the activity is not assessed as part of the student's required graduation program, inter-school athletics, intramural activities, dances, clubs, ski trips and travel abroad.
- Schools may charge for the cost of certification when the certification is not part of the requirements of the course
- Boards of Education may also offer specialty academies with the approval of the school's planning council and after consultation with parents. Boards and school planning councils must also annually approve fees for specialty academies.

The attached fee schedule meets the requirements of the legislation.

Recommendation: THAT the Board approved the attached 2013-2014 fee schedule.
