District K – 12 Words Project

Students Clair Roe, from Sperling Elementary, Bushra Gabreldar, from Chaffey-Burke Elementary and Eleanor Hoskins, from Burnaby North Secondary read their poems. Eleanor wrote her first poem in Grade 3 for the Words Project, encouraging her to become a writer.

Friends of Simon

Angela Flumerfelt, Project Coordinator for *Friends of Simon* provided an overview and short video of the Simon Fraser University initiative. The program recruits, prepares and assigns university students as literacy tutors for school-aged children who are new to the country. *Friends of Simon* supports 200 students a week at 14 different sites throughout the lower mainland. Byrne Creek Secondary and Edmonds Community School benefit from this program. Students Mohamad Adnan and Jeanne Mubalana from Byrne Creek, shared their experiences and the positive impact the program provides.

David Starr, Principal at Edmonds and David Rawnsley, Principal at Byrne Creek provided comments of their first hand experience, witnessing the positive effect in the schools. The students gain self confidence, and often contribute by volunteering and mentoring younger students in the schools.
