Superintendent's Report

School Opening Report

On Tuesday, September 6, 2011 the Board of Education welcomed students, families and staff to the 2011-2012 school year. There are 1,620 Kindergarten students starting school for the first time and 2,668 grade 12 students entering their final year of secondary school. The first day of school saw the opening of the new Burnaby Central site, an expanded Brantford Elementary School and full-day kindergarten in all of our 41 elementary schools.

Ms. Jillian Lewis, Principal of Brentwood Park Elementary introduced parent, Tara Sperling and kindergarten student, Dexter Sperling, who shared their thoughts and first impressions of their first week of school.

Burnaby Central Secondary School

On September 6, 2011 Burnaby Central opened its "new" doors to 1,281 students after three years of planning and construction. The school boasts an impressive design and some of the unique features include; LEED gold standards, enhanced athletic facilities, conference centre and a science super lab.

Principal Garth Errico along with two Burnaby Central students, Katrina Apodaca and Ryan Hirokida shared some of their experiences at the "new" Burnaby Central Secondary School.

School Enrolment

The district experienced stable enrolment over the last few years. The population for the 2011-2012 school year was projected at 23,893 for the district. A detailed report will be provided to the Board at a future meeting.
