1. Youth Summit

The district's Second Annual Youth Summit was held on October 25 at Shadbolt Centre for the Arts. Over 135 students attended from 8 secondary schools and 3 district Alternate Programs. The one-day conference, aimed at strengthening and supporting youth, offered students a series of workshops focussed on developing social emotional skills. Sessions included topics promoting fitness and nutrition, self-awareness, song writing opportunities, healthy relationships, women's self defense, dream catching seminars and more. Students enjoyed a full day of team building and sharing experiences with youth across the district.
