






Advanced Placement [®]: The Basics

- AP® courses are university-level courses offered in high school
- Courses reflect what is taught in top introductory university courses
- Students take AP Exams at the end of the course to measure their mastery of university-level work
- A score of 3 or higher on an AP Exam can typically earn students university credit and/or placement into advanced courses at university









Our AP® Courses

AP courses offered by the Burnaby School District include:

- Arts: Studio Art: Drawing Portfolio, Studio Art: 2-D Design Portfolio, Studio Art: 3-D Design Portfolio
- English: English Language and Composition, English Literature and Composition
- History and Social Sciences: European History, Macroeconomics, Microeconomics, Psychology
- Mathematics and Computer Science: Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Computer Science A, Statistics
- Sciences: Biology, Chemistry, Physics 1, Physics 2
- World languages: Chinese Language and Culture, French Language and Culture

Some interesting facts about AP in Burnaby

- Number of exams taken last year: 1815
- % of exams with a score of 3 or more: **85.3**% in Burnaby; For comparison: 82.1% BC, 76.8% Canada, Worldwide 59%
- 67 National Scholars; 92 Scholars with Distinction,
 57 Scholars with Honours and 111 Scholars
 - AP Scholars demonstrate superior university-level achievement through AP courses and exams. They receive an award certificate, and this achievement is acknowledged on any AP score report that is sent to universities the following fall.

AP®: Skills & Advantages that Last a Lifetime

- Taking an AP course helps students build critical thinking skills, confidence, and the essential time management and study skills needed for university success.
- Nationally, research shows that students who score a 3
 or higher on an AP Exam typically earn higher grade
 point averages in university and have higher graduation
 rates than their non-AP peers.*

AP® Helps Students Graduate on Time & Save Money

Students who take AP courses and exams are much more likely to complete a university degree on time.*

Graduating in four years represents a significant savings on the cost of university.

- Only 1 in 4 university students completes a bachelor's degree in 4 years.
- The average cost of university in the US for a single year is \$21,500** for public universities (in-state tuition, fees, room/board, misc. expenses).

What is the AP Capstone Program?







Introducing - AP Capstone

APCapstone is an innovative program that allows students to engage in rigorous university-level study of the critical skills necessary for success in university. The Program of study includes a 2-course sequence:

AP Seminar and AP Research

Emphasizes Critical Skills

- subject-matter study in AP
- Considering multiple perspectives
- Careful evaluation of information
- Writing evidence-based arguments

Identifying and solving problems

Complements the in-depth

- Oral communication and defending an argument
- Collaboration and teamwork





AP Seminar – Starting Fall 2014

Students learn how to:

- Investigate real-world topics from multiple perspectives
- Carefully analyze information, write evidence-based arguments and effectively communicate them
- Work independently and with a team to research a topic, develop a written report and deliver a presentation

Teachers & Students select and study 2-4 topics.

Exam score based on:

- Team Project & Presentation
 - 25%



- Individual Essay & Presentation
 - 35%
- 3. Written Exam
 - 40%







AP Research – Starting Fall 2015

Students learn how to:

- Design, plan, and conduct a year-long mentored, researchbased investigation
- Apply research methods and practices to address a real-world topic selected by the student
- Write a university-level research paper, present and orally defend the findings and research methodology

Exam score based on:

- Research Process
 - 15%



- 2. Academic Thesis Paper (~5,000 words)
 - 70%
- Public Presentation and Oral Defense
 - 15%

AP Seminar is a prerequisite to AP Research.








AP Capstone Program Model

A two-course sequence that provides students with the critical thinking and research skills needed to succeed in university and stand-out in the admission process









AP[®] Capstone Exam Fees

- There are exam fees for AP Seminar and AP Research. Fees for these two course have yet to be determined.
- There is also an AP Exam fee for each AP course.
 Currently, the fee is \$120 for each exam.
- There are no fees for taking the AP Seminar or AP Research course.

AP Capstone: The Benefits

- Distinction Stand out in the university admission process and have the opportunity to earn valuable university credit or placement
- Critical Skills Students acquire rigorous university-level analysis, writing, and research skills that are increasingly valued by universities

• **Choice** – Students choose their own research topic and study issues and topics of interest and importance to them

AP Capstone: Application Information

- The application requires
 - a completed application form
 - student written responses
 - a parent questionnaire, and
 - a teacher recommendation
- Send applications to the Burnaby District Office, attention June Evans
- Please note that if accepted to the Program, students may need to transfer to Burnaby North or Burnaby South.

AP Capstone: Start the Conversation

Help your child prepare to talk to a teacher or counselor about AP Capstone. Here are some questions to encourage your child to think about:

Is AP Capstone right for me?

Before you talk to a teacher or counselor, think about what interests you:

- What university majors are you considering? What careers excite you?
- Do I enjoy challenging myself to think in new ways?
- Do I like to collaborate and learn from others?

Ask your counselor or teacher the following questions:

- May I speak with a teacher familiar with AP Capstone?
- How will the courses be structured in the school schedule?
- Are there other courses that can help me succeed in AP Capstone?
