BC Education Restart Plan

- Increase in-class instruction K-12 in a gradual and controlled manner
- Ensure health and safety measures to reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission are in place
- School density targets established to ensure numbers are manageable and align with public health guidelines.
- Return to in-class instruction is voluntary for families

K-7 In-Class Instruction

- In-class instruction for elementary students:
 - Kindergarten to Grade 5: 2 days per week
 - Grades 6-7: 1 day per week
 - Children of Essential Service Workers (K-Grade 5), students with disabilities/diverse abilities (K-Grade 7): 5 days per week (if requested by parents/guardians)
- In-class instruction will support remote learning

K-7 Return to School Schedule

K-5 @ 40% (2 days) and 6-7 @ 20% (1 day)

Considerations for K-7 Schedule

- Ensure groups are balanced and meet density targets
 - Kindergarten: 9
 - Grades 1-3: 10
 - Grades 4-5: 14
 - Grades 6-7: 14
- Siblings/Children in the same family attending the same day(s)
- Staggered start/end times
- Staggered recess/lunch breaks

8-12 In-Class Instruction

- In-class instruction for secondary students:
 - Grades 8-12: Up to 1 day per week
 - Students with disabilities/diverse abilities: 5 days per week (if requested by parents/guardians)
- In-class instruction will support remote learning

Considerations for 8-12 Schedule

- Regular block rotation
- Not dependent on students making appointments
- Maintain Day 1/Day 2 structure
- Same cohorts of students in the building
- Scalable for changes in density now or in the fall
- Time built in for year end activities

Continuity of Learning

- Remote learning opportunities supported by in-school instruction
- Open-ended learning opportunities provide continuity between in-class and remote learning experiences
- Literacy, Numeracy, Social Emotional Learning and The First Peoples' Principles of Learning will continue to be a focus.

Continuity of Learning

- Encourage learning activities that can take place outside, creating activities that involve physical and health education
- Activities, assignments, and assessments will be accessible to students and families for both in-class and remote learning
