Words Contest Entry Information

Please be aware of the following criteria for student submissions:

- All submissions need to be uploaded to the <u>Words Submission Form</u>. The piece will be published as submitted, so please proofread carefully!
- Please upload your submission with the naming convention "School_StudentName_Grade.docx"
- The focus of the contest and the publication is excellence in writing.
- All entries must be original work from students currently enrolled at your school.
- All submissions must have been written during the current (2020-21) school year. Submissions which have been previously published are not eligible.
- All entries must be suitable for general audience publication.
- The total number of entries a school may submit must not exceed five per cent of the school's total student population.
- All entries should be typed, been thoroughly proofread and submitted as a Word document which is ready for publication. We are requesting submissions be in the font Arial, 12 point. Please do not include pictures, as we are unable to publish them.

All entries are to be submitted no later than Friday, March 5, 2021.

Only those chosen as finalists will have their work included in the WORDS publication.
