Superintendent's Report

Burnaby North Students Create Published Book

Dave Rawnsley, Burnaby North principal, introduced students and staff from the ACCESS program, an exceptional community, who had created and published a book called "1,2,3, Count with Me, A Bug Can Count if You Believe". Judy Chiao, ACCESS teacher, and Patti Jensen, Educational Assistant, described how students of diverse abilities had come together to share their talents in a project that had taken two and a half years to complete. Aaron Waddington (Grade 12), described his use of Photoshop in the project and said the students wanted to show that creativity and team work is more important than making money. Leo Yamamoto (who had graduated in 2019) read an extract from the book.

Mental Health and Wellness in Burnaby Schools

Nick Christofides, District Vice-Principal – Safe and Caring Schools, provided an update on mental health literacy and wellbeing in the district. The COVID-19 pandemic had caused many changes in the lives of students and staff. The Mental Health Literacy Team was providing additional mental health liaison to help with outreach and vulnerable students, providing a mental health resource package for all staff, providing online opportunities for classes (on mindfulness, stress management, positive psychology) and school-based resource teams were identifying students that needed support. The team was also supporting schools and staff in 'trauma-sensitive schools' training, piloting a Quest for Rest Sleep Health program with BC's Children's Hospital and working with the District Student Advisory Council to use "student voice" as a way to build our mental health framework from the ground up.

It was moved by Larry Hayes and seconded by Bill Brassington:
