- No funding announced for COVID-19 related expenditures



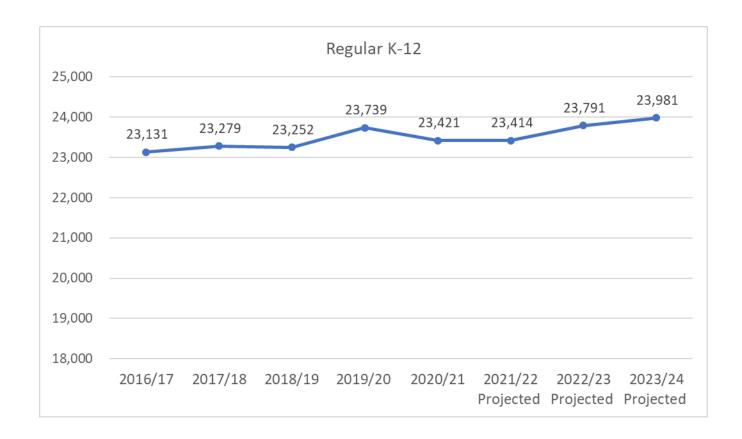
