Board Chair Report

Jen Mezei, Chair, welcomed everyone to the meeting. Back on March 6, 2020 the district began a dialogue about our sustainability aspirations to help inform the development of the first Burnaby School District Sustainability Strategic Plan. Although the timelines of our priorities may have shifted, our commitment to sustainability is unwavering and remains constant.

The Sustainability Strategic Plan is a set of objectives and goals that empower our schools' communities and enable staff, students, and community members to help lead us towards becoming a more sustainable district. When we work collectively as a community through our individual roles, we can co-create something much more powerful as we amplify our single voices to a collective roar. It is a reminder of how important it is in our governance role to first listen with respect and open minds so we can continue to grow, change, and improve together.

District Operations – Superintendent's Report

Youth Development Instrument

The Youth Development Instrument (YDI) is a self report survey of grade 11 students created to identify which resources, opportunities, and practices set youth up for success in adolescence and adulthood. Modelled after the Early Development Instrument and the Middle Years Development Instrument, the YDI was developed by researchers at Simon Fraser University, the University of British Columbia Human Early Learning Partnership, and the British Columbia Centre for Disease Control, in collaboration with school administrators, teachers, healthcare providers, policymakers, community partners and young people.

Participating in the 2021/2022 pilot are Burnaby Mountain and Burnaby North Secondary Schools, and Byrne Creek Community Secondary School. After the survey has been delivered the district will receive individual school-level reports and one overall district report.

Sheri Brattston, Managing Director of Community Education, and Bal Dhillon, Community School Coordinator at Byrne Creek Community School, joined secondary students Ervin Cadiz and Clifford Ocampo as the students reflected on their experiences over the past two years at school, at home, and in their community that have impacted their well-being, resilience, and positive mental health.

Local Indigenous Artist Designs Pink Shirt for Burnaby School District
