POLICY

TEACHING ASSIGNMENTS IN THE DISTRICT THAT PROVIDE INSTRUCTION AND SUPPORT TO STUDENTS IN COURSES AND PROGRAMS THAT LEAD TO GRADUATION WILL BE SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS THAT ARE OUTLINED IN THE SCHOOL ACT AND THE TEACHING PROFESSION ACT.

TEACHING ASSIGNMENTS IN THE DISTRICT THAT PROVIDE INSTRUCTION AND SUPPORT FOR EARLY LEARNING AND ADULT PROGRAMS WILL BE SUBJECT TO THE SPECIFIC CREDENTIALS REQUIRED BY THE DISTRICT IN ORDER TO INSTRUCT IN THAT PROGRAM AREA.

OBJECTIVE

To ensure that all teachers employed in the school district meet the professional, legislative and knowledge standards that are required.
