## 1. Premier's Award for Excellence in Education

The Premier's Awards for Excellence in Education were created to recognize the exceptional contributions of BC's teachers, administrators and support staff. On October 26, 2023, nominees were invited to Victoria to receive recognition and their award from the Premier of British Columbia and the Minister of Education and Childcare. Award recipients from across the province were recognized for their outstanding leadership and commitment to education.
