1. Governor General Awards

Lord Dufferin, Canada's third Governor General after Confederation, created the Academic Medals in 1873 to encourage academic excellence across the nation. Over the years they have become the most prestigious award that students in Canadian Schools can receive. Each year, the Governor General's Academic Medal is awarded to the top student at each secondary school in Canada.

For over 150 years, the Governor General's Academic Medals have been awarded to students graduating with the highest grade point average from a secondary school, as well as from approved colleges or university programs. The medals are presented on behalf of the Governor General through each of the District's secondary schools.

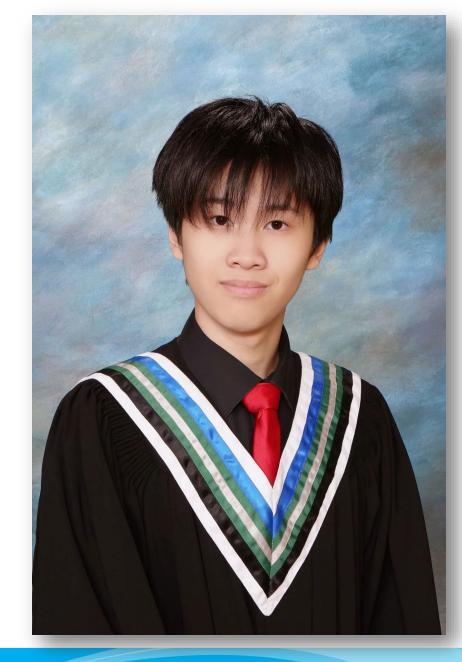
