## ▶ TUITION-FREE?

Elementary students who meet the following criteria are eligible to take **one tuition-free morning academic course**. All afternoon activity programs are fee paying.

**Your child must:**

- be a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident or convention refugee
- have attended a BC school in the 2025-2026 school year and ordinarily reside in BC with a parent/guardian
- have a BC Personal Education Number (PEN)

Those not eligible, or those signing up for courses requiring fees can pay by Visa or Mastercard.

**NOTE: Transfers & refund requests must be made by noon on July 6.**

## ▶ Inclusive Education

If your child has an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) and/or a Fraser Health Care Plan and is currently receiving additional support provided by an Education Assistant (EA) at school, we encourage you to complete the online registration **by May 1** to evaluate the level of support necessary for your child. Registration decisions will be made until the **middle of June**.

Please only reach out to the Summer Session office **after June 15** if you have not received information about your child's registration status.

- The student is new to a Burnaby public school this year and began after March 11, OR
- The student's school is outside of the Burnaby Public School District

**Please be sure to have the following documents ready during the online registration process:**

- Proof of student's birthdate:** birth certificate or passport
- Proof of guardianship:** parents' or guardians' as shown on birth certificate or other appropriate legal documentation such as landed immigrant papers or guardianship "order" granted by the courts
- Proof of citizenship for both parent and the student:** Canadian birth certificate, citizenship card, passport, landed immigrant document, permanent resident card
- Proof of residency of the parent/guardian and student.** Two pieces required, with at least one being from Category A:
  - ▶ **Category A:** proof of ownership of dwelling (i.e. purchase contract, property assessment, annual municipal utility/tax statement); long term lease/rental agreement; parent or guardian's income tax return or notice of assessment from Revenue Canada
  - ▶ **Category B:** BC Hydro bill, BC cable bill, provincial driver's license, provincial registration of automobile, Canadian bank account or credit card statement
- Copy of student's most recent school marks:** report card or transcript of academic record
- BC Personal Education Number (PEN)**
- IEP (Learning Support, if applicable)**

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**Upon approval, you will receive notification about your eligibility to register for Summer Session courses with the Burnaby School District.**

# **MORNING - Academic Course Descriptions**

ONE TUITION-FREE ACADEMIC COURSE PER ELIGIBLE STUDENT

Eligible Students: Tuition Free | Fee Paying Students: \$700

## ▶ **Adventures in Music**

Come and spend your mornings playing with music! A variety of methods will be used to learn music. You will play musical games outside and then come inside to play rhythms and melodies on a variety of instruments.

## ▶ **Adventures in Reading**

Develop an appreciation for the enjoyment of literature, increase confidence with printed word, and explore different types of genres as you journey into the world of reading.

## ▶ **Advanced Crochet**

This course is designed for students who already have a foundational understanding of crochet and are ready to expand their skills through more complex projects and techniques. This Advanced Crochet program will build on the basics students have already mastered. To ensure a productive and enjoyable learning experience, participating students should already feel comfortable with slip knots, chain stitches, single crochet, and magic circle. Throughout the course, students will learn intermediate and advanced stitches, follow multi-step patterns, create 3D projects and amigurumi-style pieces, develop pattern-reading skills and strengthen hand-eye coordination and creative problem-solving.

## ▶ **Art**

These classes are teacher specific and will vary in content depending on the passion of the teacher. Projects may include drawing, painting, printmaking, image development, stitch work, clay work, or sewing.

## ▶ **Bandlab**

This course focuses on teaching essential skills in recording, beat-making, and music creation, utilizing Bandlab or Digital Audio Workstation (DAW). The program will provide students with a beginning foundation in digital music and audio production.

## ▶ **Beginner Guitar**

Learn the basics of playing an acoustic guitar. Learn how to play chords, count rhythms and beats, and how to pick notes as you work to perform a number of pop songs.

## ▶ **Brain Gymnastics - French Immersion**

Only students currently enrolled in a French Immersion program are eligible for this course as all instruction will be in French. Give your brain a fun workout every day! Learn strategies to see fascinating puzzles from different perspectives and find creative solutions to interesting challenges.

## ▶ **Ceramics and Printmaking**

Ceramics and Printmaking is a hands-on art session where students will explore both clay and print-based art. Students may create pinch pots, small sculptures, or glazed ceramic pieces, while exploring printmaking through sun prints, stamp making, or simple print processes. With an emphasis on creativity and process over perfection, students will build confidence, fine motor skills, and take home a collection of unique, handmade artworks.

### ▶ **Comic Creation**

This course is intended to spark students' love for writing by exploring the popular medium of comic creation! Students will learn about key parts of effective comic strips.

### ▶ **Cooking**

In this course, students will be learning to cook or bake a variety of sweet and savory dishes. In addition, the students will practice and learn about different aspects of healthy eating.

### ▶ **Engineering**

If you enjoy hands-on engineering projects this course is for you! You will design and build creative solutions to various challenges using common hand tools in a safe and creative environment.

### ▶ **Exploring Science (Primary & Intermediate)**

Students in both the primary and intermediate programs will have fun while learning scientific principles and methods through a number of hands-on exploratory activities.

### ▶ **Fibre Arts & Design**

In this course students will explore a series of fibre related activities which may include spinning wool, sewing, felting, crocheting and design thinking. Students will engage in creative and cooperative challenges and will develop hands-on skills in several areas.

### ▶ **French Immersion Primary**

For students who are currently enrolled in a French Immersion program, this course will continue a variety of fun activities presented in French. **STUDENTS MUST HAVE BEEN ENROLLED IN A FRENCH IMMERSION CLASSROOM DURING THE 2025/2026 SCHOOL YEAR.**
